

January 8, 2018

The Wimbledon City Council convened in regular session with Mayor Pickar presiding. Present were Councilmen Bakken, Guscette, Plumb and Smith. Also present were Wade Senger, Brent Christ and Mary Beth Olombel.

The minutes of the December meeting were read and approved.

**Old Business:**

Councilman Smith reported that he has not heard from either the States Attorney or the Barnes Co Sheriff's Dept. concerning the fan noise problem in the city.

Councilman Smith also reported that a resident had been bitten by a dog and that papers have been filed.

Auditor reported that Doug Johnson has agreed to purchase the North end of lot 9 Original Wimbledon and will have the quit claim deed drawn up as requested.

**New Business:**

Wade Senger of Interstate Engineers brought the council up to date on the progress of applying for funds to replace the stand pipe on the city water tower.

Brent Christ, representing the fire department, approached the council to report that Mark McClean is the new Fire Chief and Chad Bakken is the assistant Chief. He also requested permission from the city for the department to change the mud run area of the park so that they can hold truck pulling competition in July. Permission was granted.

Auditor reported that one of the requests that came from the community meeting held on December 13<sup>th</sup> was for a bench by the playground equipment in the city park. Auditor is to check into getting a bench.

Councilman Plumb made a motion, seconded by Bakken, to pay all bills. Ayes 4 and Nays 0.

There being no further business to come before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
