The Wimbledon City Council convened in regular session with Mayor Pickar presiding. Present were Councilmen Bakken, Hoggarth and Smith. Kurt Wagner was also present.

The minutes of the February meeting were read and approved.

Old Business:

Second reading of amendment to dog ordinance. The head of the household or responsible adult will be responsible for any dog, kept either on a permanent or temporary basis at their place of residence, and will be the person liable when the dog is permitted to be at large. All dogs must be licensed to establish ownership and to prove all shots are up to date.

New Business:

Kurt Wagner, representing the Fire Department, inquired about the fire department purchasing the land where the mud drags are held so that they would not be out their money when improvements are made to the lot. After discussion, the council agreed to give the department first chance on buying the lot if the city should ever decide to sell.

Councilman Bakken reported that Agroline should be commended for going around town and clearing the snow around the fire hydrants and cleaning up Main Street after a couple of the storms.

Councilman Bakken made a motion, seconded by Smith to pay all bills.

There being no further business to come before the council the meeting was adjourned.
