The Wimbledon City Council convened in regular session with Mayor Pickar presiding. Present were Councilmen Bakken, Hoggarth and Smith. Also present were Les Koll, Kurt Wagner, and Mary Beth Olombel.

The December minutes were read and corrected. Minutes were approved as corrected.

**Old Business:**

Auditor reported that he had received a letter from the Barnes Co States Attorney suggesting that the city amend their dog ordinance to read that the owner of a property where the dog resides is responsible when the dog is allowed to be at large.

**New Business:**

Kurt Wagner, representing the fire dept. Requesting permission to bury an electric line out to where they hold their mud drags. The matter was tabled until later when they plan to do the work.

Les Koll approached the council as a member of the museum board asking about the lots to the north of the museum. The city will need to do some checking to come up with a price.

Les reported that some trees in the city need to be trimmed in order for the maintainer to plow some of the streets. He also reported that there is a mailbox that needs to be moved in order to maintain the street. Party was notified.

Also discussed was the pump at the well. Cenex has put in a reserve tank at the seed plant but the pump at the well is not working right.
